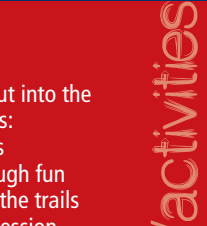
Trailblazers Project

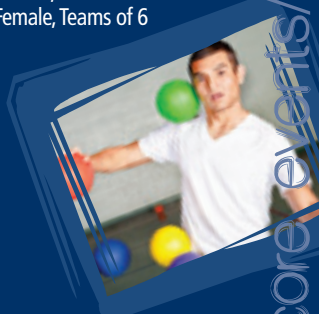

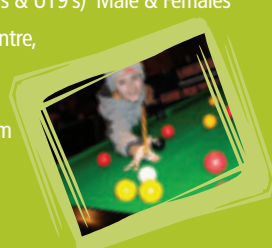
